## Welcome to the Class-based Adult Basic Education Science, Math, & Humanities Departments

The Adult Basic Education (ABE) Science, Math, and Humanities Departments offer class-based courses from high school upgrading to 1<sup>st</sup> year university transfer courses, which include Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Anatomy and Physiology, Math, Statistics, Calculus, Writing Skills, English, Economics, Psychology, and Sociology. Choose from day, afternoon or evening courses. Classes start Jan., March, May, July, September, and November. (**Note:** The College and Career Access Department offers some but not all of the class-based upgrading courses listed below in a self-paced environment as well. Contact the College and Career Access Department for a list of self-paced courses. **Note**, too, that College Preparatory and ESL students may NOT register in upgrading/high school English courses)
